**Privacy notice for Customers
of Carter Process Control GmbH
according to Art. 13 GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)**

1. Data Processing

- order-related data (offer, order confirmation, invoices, etc.),
- communication/correspondence related to these activities;

2. Newsletter Data Processing

In order to keep our customers up to date about our products, services and events within the framework of our customer relationship, CPC sends out E-Mail-Newsletters.

Legal basis:

- Legitimate interests (Art. 6 (1) lit. f DSGVO): this data processing is necessary to facilitate an appropriate customer relationship. It is essential to inform our customers about products in the framework of our customer relationship.

Receiver:

- personal data collected will not be transferred to any third parties.

3. Storage period

We process your personal data until the termination of the contractual relationship or until the expiration of the applicable statutory limitation and retention periods. Furthermore, until the termination of any legal disputes in which the data is required as evidence. As far as the processing is based on a declaration of consent and there is no other legal justification basis for processing the data, the processing takes place until revocation.

The processing of personal data for sending newsletters is carried out as long as there is no rejection of this electronic contact information (newsletter).

4. Rights of the data subject

You have the right to obtain information about your processed personal data, to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data, to obtain the erasure of your personal data, to obtain the restriction of
